

# Conflict Awareness & Response Education (C.A.R.E.)

#### PARENT INFORMATION SHEET

This intervention focuses on helping students understand better ways to respond to conflict, strategies of de-escalation, and approaches to problem solving through discussion and reflection.

## **Intervention & Education Program**
